



Population: Iowa's Counties 1990 - 2010

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Iowa gained 120,031 residents (4.1%) between the decennial censuses of 2000 and 2010 surpassing three million in population at a census for the first time (Table 1, Figures 1-2). The increases for the decade were somewhat lower in both number and percent than the gains between 1990 and 2000 (+149,569; +5.4%). The changes among the 99 counties were variable with 33 counties experiencing an increase in population while 66 counties registered declines between 2000 and 2010 (Table 1, Figure 1).

Many of the counties that increased were located in a band from central Iowa eastward to the Quad Cities area (Figure 1). Polk County's gain of 56,000 residents was the most of any county, giving it a population exceeding 400,000 for the first time (Table 1). Dallas County's percentage increase (62.3%) was triple that of the next highest county (Johnson, 17.9%) and Dallas had substantial numerical gain (+25,300) as well. Polk, Linn, Scott, Black Hawk, and Johnson were the state's five largest counties having a combined population of nearly 1,070,000 and 35 percent of the state's total residents. Adams County was the smallest (4,029).

Counties with population loss could be found across the state, but were more likely in northern, western, and southern areas of Iowa. For a few of these counties, the loss was small in both numerical and percentage terms. Franklin County declined by 24 residents (-0.2%) and Monroe County by 46 (-0.6%) (Table 1). For many counties, however, the declines were substantial. Four (Cerro Gordo, Des Moines, Lee, Webster) lost 2,000 or more residents while 13 others declined by at least 1,000. Nine counties (Adams, Audubon, Calhoun, Greene, Ida, Kossuth, Pocahontas, Sac, Taylor) registered losses of nine percent or more and another 25 experienced at least a five percent loss. The 15 percent decrease for Pocahontas County was the largest percentage decline for any county in the state.

In recent decades, significant numbers of counties have registered a population decline at a census. Between 1990 and 2000, 45 counties experienced a population loss while 54 showed a gain. The decade of 1980 to 1990 was especially hard on Iowa's population. During that time, Iowa lost 4.7 percent of its residents (-137,000) with 92 counties showing population loss (Figure 2).

Figure 1. Population Change 2000 - 2010




